The courses

We offer a wide range of courses:

- Graduate or Intensive Group Courses,
- Thematic Workshops,
- Individual and group classes on demand,

as well as a wide schedule.

Graduate or Intensive Group Courses

Our levels are aligned with those of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). They cover the learning of the general Italian, from the beginner level A1 to the bilingual level C2, and are based on the acquisition of skills. Intermediate students undergo an assessment test to determine their starting level.

Course Programs

Beginner (A1)	Grammar: fundamental elements; spelling; Phonetics, basic vocabulary; Oral and written exercises; Dictation; Functional texts: email, sms, cards; Guided conversation; Simple readings.
Elementary (A2)	Grammar: progression and enrichment of knowledge; spelling; Pronunciation; vocabulary; idiomatic expressions; Oral and written exercises; Dictation; Writing simple texts; Readings; Guided conversation.
Intermediate I (B1)	Grammar and syntax: revision of knowledge, progression and deepening; Oral and written exercises; Dictations, letters, abstracts; Readings with linguistic analysis; Semi-guided conversation.
Intermediate II (B2)	As for intermediate course I; With analysis of literary texts and newspaper articles. Oral and written work on topics of general interest. References to Italian culture more punctual.
Advanced (C1)	Grammar and syntax: improvement at different levels. Study of various texts. Literature: choice of authors, commentary and analysis of the works studied. Explanation of texts. Conversation, writing of varied texts. Deepening of the various aspects of Italian culture.
Superior (C2)	Improvement and deepening of the Italian language and culture. Towards an ever more autonomous and fluid use of the language.
Conversation	Conversation from texts and audiovisual

	recordings. Practice speaking, understanding and understanding; To express themselves in an appropriate and fluid manner.
Reading circle	Reading and analysis of novels, literary extracts and current affairs. Discovery tour around a theme, reading and conversing
